



COVID-19 Special Guidelines

Gate Admission Process:

- Attendance will be limited to racers, crew members and their immediate families only, sorry for the time being, general spectating is not opened to the public yet.
- Upon entry, you will be greeted by our staff wearing personal protective equipment (PPE), i.e., facemask and gloves.
- Each vehicle will be given a separate liability release/waiver for the occupants to sign and return to staff at the gate. Only one release sheet will be used per vehicle.
- Each rider will be given a race entry registration form to complete on their own prior to returning it to the yellow registration trailer.
- Please bring your own pen to complete the release and race entry form.
- We will only accept exact cash payment for gate entry fees, change will not be given. Please come prepared with plenty of small bills.
- Gate fees are \$15 per person ages 13+, \$10 per person ages 6-12, ages 5 & under are free!
- Your ticket will be a wristband. Please secure it to your own wrist and help your kids with theirs.
- We have trash bags if you need one. Please pickup and dispose of your trash in our dump trailer located near gates on your way home.
- Park no less than 10 feet apart from your neighbor on all sides.
- Please remain in your pit area unless going to/from registration, start line or the racetrack. Do not roam or visit your neighbors - use your phone for that.

Registration Process:

- We will only accept exact cash payment for race entry registration & transponder fees, change will not be given. Please come prepared with plenty of small bills.
- Race Fees are as follows, Peewee Divisions \$25, Youth Divisions \$30, Adult Divisions \$35 & Pro Classes \$45. Transponders are a one-time purchase of \$10 if you do not already have one.
- We ask that only the rider, or in the event of a youth rider one parent, bring the riders completed registration form and helmet to the yellow registration trailer. Youth riders should not attend registration. Due to social distancing concerns, racers or parents should wear facemasks to registration.
- Clerks will be seated behind protective barriers for your protection and theirs.
- Standing positions will be marked 6 feet apart for social distancing. Please stand apart while waiting you turn.

Race Procedures:

- Only 1 rider / 1 parent/mechanic allowed on the Start Line. Due to social distancing concerns, mechanics should wear facemasks on the Start Line.
- Riders must ride alone and may not transport anyone on their machines, unless they are members of the same household who followed the stay-at-home order together.
- Riders wearing helmets are not required to wear a facemask
- Podium celebrations and interviews will be suspended until further notice. We will use the rear vendor window of the yellow registration trailer as an Award Center to distribute awards/plaques. Racers should wear your facemasks when you come to pick up awards after your race and remember to use social distancing practices.

Special Health Considerations:

- Social distancing is key. That means standing at least 6 feet apart from one another.
- Family members who have quarantined together are not expected to social distance from one another.
- Wear a face cover when you are unable to social distance or stand 6 feet apart. Bring your own mask. Just use common sense. Besides, it is cool to be covered!
- Wash your hands often and use hand sanitizer. We will have handwashing stations and hand sanitizer available.
- Please do not offer to shake hands with anyone.
- **The CDC recommends persons who are sick with fever or cough, the elderly or those at high risk, to stay home. We do too. Please do not attend our event if this is you.**
- Please take your own temperature before you leave home. If you have a temperature of at least 100.4, you have a fever and should stay home.
- If you know you have had contact with someone diagnosed with having COVID-19 in the last 14 days, or you yourself have had COVID-19 in the last 30 days, please stay home.
- Respect the local community – wear facemasks or shields, gloves and wash your hands when supporting local businesses.
